

2000W HAIR DRYERS RECOMMENDED MAINTENANCE

The hair dryer supplied with your timer is rated as <u>a domestic unit and</u>, <u>as such</u>, <u>is suitable</u> <u>for light use only</u>. In order to prolong the life of the unit it is recommended that regular maintenance is carried out to keep the vents and openings clear from dust and debris.

Attention: Before cleaning or maintenance is carried out on the dryer, ensure power is isolated to the unit.

Cleaning the Air Filter and Air Intake Vent

From time to time, check the Air Filter and Air Intake Vent for dust and debris build up. Cleaning the filter and vent helps to prevent the dryer from overheating. The filter is located at the back of the dryer.

Removable Filter Cover

Remove the Filter Cover and use a small dry cloth to remove build up from the Air Filter and Filter Cover.

Use a small cleaning brush to remove build up from the Air Filter. Brush off any build up from the Air Intake Vent while holding the dryer upside down.

Note: Do not use the dryer without the Filter Cover.

Non Removable Filter Cover

If the filter cover cannot be removed, brush the grill of your hair dryer and use a vacuum cleaner or a small brush to clean the grill and filter screen on the hair dryer intake filter. This will remove hair, dust and lint.

NB: The warranty is invalid if hair dryer fails due to over heating.
