

RECONDITIONED PREPAYMENT FERRANTI COIN METER

Changing the coin action

- 1. Remove the cash box
- 2. Unscrew the knurled nut
-) see picture
- 3. Push lever towards rear of the meter
-) to right
- 4. Pull the coin action to the right to remove it from the meter
- 5. Simply reverse these instructions to replace coin action



Altering the units per coin setting

The Ferranti meter has a variable tariff based on units per coin (separate information sheet available on how to convert units per coin to pence per unit). As a guide we set our £1.00 coin meters at 8 units per coin which is the equivalent of 12 pence per unit of electricity. To alter the units per coin setting:-

- 1. Break the yellow seal (See pictures A & B) on the hinged large (A) or small (B) window and open the window or;
- If you have a small window with an armed cash box you will need to remove the cash box and undo the screw under the arm to open the window (See picture C)
- 3. Gently pull the pointer towards you then up (See Picture A) slide it to the desired setting and then press it gently back into the mechanism
- 4. <u>Do not press the black plunger</u> because you will lose any credit on the meter
- 5. Close the window and reseal with a yellow meter seal or replace the armed cash box
